### **Day 1. Wed 21 Feb: Home – Lakes Entrance (MT/L/AT/D)**

Good morning and welcome aboard. Let's begin our journey to Beautiful Lakes Entrance. We will stop along the way for morning tea before arriving at the quaint town of Rosedale where we will enjoy a gorgeous High Tea lunch at the Victoria Rose Tea Rooms. After lunch we head to Paynesville where we will board the ferry across to Raymond Island. The Island has a unique history as an early fishing station, small mixed farming holdings when horses and cattle used to swim the Strait, and as a post WWII weekend holiday retreat. The Island is 6 km long and 2 km wide. Over 500 people call the Island home, and holiday makers swell the population during summer. Raymond Island draws nature lovers for some of the best koala-spotting around. After a lovely trip around the Island looking at the local wildlife and flora we will stop at Ferry Park for a snack before heading back towards the mainland. From Paynesville we make our way to Lakes Entrance and arrive at our motel with time to freshen up before a lovely meal in the beautiful motel Restaurant.

### **Day 2. Thur 22 Feb: Lakes Entrance - Home (B/MT/L)**

After a hearty, cooked breakfast we meet up with our guide and head off to tour the town and learn a little more about the history of Lakes Entrance. We then begin to slowly weave our way towards home stopping at Wa-De-Lock cellar door in the lovely town of Stratford on Avon for Morning Tea with some of the largest scones you will ever see! We make our way to Port Albert to enjoy some fish and chips on the Wharf before heading to the Maritime Museum. Port Albert was the original Port of Entry for the Gippsland Gold Fields and the old bank vault houses a display on Gippsland Gold Discovery. Here our guide will chat with us about the history of this maritime village. We then head back towards home with comfort stops along the way arriving early evening after enjoying our lovely little getaway.
