## **Day 1. Mon 4<sup>th</sup> June: Home - Marysville**

Good morning and welcome aboard. Let's begin our journey to Magical Marysville. We travel towards Healesville where we will stop for Morning tea and a little free time to look around this gorgeous country town. We then head along the Black Spur to the Black Spur Inn. The Inn was used as a refuge during the 2009 Black Saturday Bushfires and was spared by the great firestorm that claimed many lives and destroyed large parts of the Murrindindi region. After a light lunch we head straight to Marysville stopping at the Information Centre. Informative displays and videos will deliver a wealth of information about the history of this lovely village. We will then have some time to explore Gallipoli Park. The Gallipoli Park precinct underwent a \$1.8 million park redevelopment following the Black Saturday bushfires in 2009, which included a state-of-the-art children's playground and reflective garden. Spend some time in the garden or exploring the town. After checking in to our motel with plenty of time to freshen up we will enjoy a lovely 2 course dinner. Sleep well surrounded by the fresh mountain air.

## **Day 2. Tues 5<sup>th</sup> June: Marysville - Home**

After a hearty breakfast we collect Pete – our local tour guide. Pete will join us on the bus to guide us through the Marysville township. He loves a chat and is full of local tidbits and information. After learning more about the quaint little town we will accompany Pete back to his shed, housing a large collection of Massey Ferguson tractor's including one of the famous "Double Doe" tractor's. As you walk into Pete's Shed you will also notice a dedicated memorial and museum to the 2009 fires, featuring an extensive range of photographs from before, during and after the fires and various artefacts that were salvaged from the intense fires. We then spend some time with Linda (Pete's wife) who will make us a scrumptious morning tea and show us around her Crystal Garden. We bid farewell to this lovely couple and make our way to Brunos Sculpture Garden. Established in 1996, Brunos Art and Sculpture Garden has been a paradise for art and garden lovers alike. Since the February 2009 fires, Bruno has rebuilt his home and gallery. The garden has blossomed into a new stage of life, most of his terracotta life size sculptures have been restored and you can see his surviving paintings as well as new works in the unique new gallery space. We then make our way to Steavensons Falls one of the highest waterfalls in Australia which has a drop of 84 metres. We can't have a trip to Marysville without enjoying lunch at the fabulous Marysville Country Bakery before heading back home after a lovely little getaway to magical Marysville.
